This 2.67 mile project includes the total reconstruct of N. 76th Street from Clinton Avenue to West County Line Road in Milwaukee County. The original concrete pavement project, built in the late 1960's, will now be replaced with a full depth asphalt pavement. Included with the project are grading, sewers, concrete curbs, sidewalks, traffic signals, and all signing and pavement marking. There is also the removal and replacement of the Brown Deer Road bridge deck along with repainting. The railroad bridge also on the project will have surface repair and the girders will be repainted.
