This 4-mile, 2-lane new roadway includes the expansion of USH 14 from STH 138 to STH 92, new interchange at USH 14 and STH 138, and the reconstruction of STH 138 from Hill Road to Park Street in the Village of Oregon. Right-of-way for this project was purchased in 1966 due to anticipated expansion; therefore no right-of-way purchase is needed. This project will tie into the 4-lane, USH 14 roadway capacity expansion that is to be built in 2008. Commuters traveling north into Madison from STH 138 produce high traffic volumes expressing the need for capacity expansion and new interchange. Extensive public involvement activities and coordination with local officials is vital to the success of this project. A few public road access points will be re-aligned or combined to promote roadway safety for the area residents.
